Algebraic Chess Notation - CH2V

There are many good reasons for writing down your chess moves: Chess notation enables you to record your games for playback later Replaying your games with chess notation enables you to analyze your games so that you can correct any mistakes you made and improve your chess play Chess competitions actually require recording of moves from the
